Pedagogic flute: Already many hundreds of satisfied customers

New product: Flute in sib

This flute is deducted from the pedagogic flute, but is a bit longer so that it plays a tone lower (transposition instrument in sib).

The sound is clear and strong in 2 and a half octave and one can play in the tones Do major and Fa major. Also for this flute, the perfect acoustic quality is due to the cylindrical inner form (like the Boehm flutes) and to the care which has been paid to the form of the mouthpiece and the dimensions and diameters of the holes. Made of anodised aluminium, stands for an indestructible and scratch-free instrument.

New product: Irish flute

Flute in anodised aluminium, exceedingly suited for playing the Irish music.
This instrument not only offers the same

acoustic quality as a traditional Irish flute such as a clear and strong sound (also in the lower tones), but is besides shock-resistant,

scratch-free, insensible to moisture, maintenance-free, and almost indestructible.

In a certain way, this instrument breaks with certain traditions of the old flutes from the baroque, which are still an inspiration for the actual artisanal Irish flute.

But the innovative design, the well-considered profile of the mouthpiece, the cylindrical inner form, and the accuracy of the production, are providing a superb unprecedented rich sound.
